Welcome to Eastern Illinois University. We hope you have an active, safe, and enjoyable week.

- All indoor activities take place in the Student Recreation Center (SRC) and the Lantz Building.
The SRC is adjacent to Lantz Arena.
- No open toed shoes (sandals) are permitted in the rec center.
- All outdoor activities take place on the fields south of Lantz at the I-M Sports Pavilion.
- Enter the Lantz Building from the pond side (south) at ground level and continue to the north through the hallway to the SRC.
- Basketball, Volleyball, and Table Tennis are all played in the SRC.
- Tennis will be played on the Lantz courts southeast of the Field-house or in the Field-house in case of rain.
- Enter the Lantz pool from the locker room on ground floor.
- POST ACTIVITY SHOWER should be taken in the residence halls since no towels are provided at Lantz.

SPORTS EQUIPMENT ISSUE ROOM HOURS

The equipment is issued at the SRC counter located in the SRC office area. Enter the Lantz Building on the ground level as you enter from the south side near the campus pond. The locker room is the first doors on the left before going down the hall to the SRC. Outdoor equipment is available at the Intramural Field Pavilion at the hours listed below.

Sunday..... 2:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. (Equipment at SRC Office)

Mon. - Thurs..... 3:30 p.m. - 6:00 p.m.

A Boys State identification card is required to check out all athletic equipment. Equipment must be returned on a daily basis.

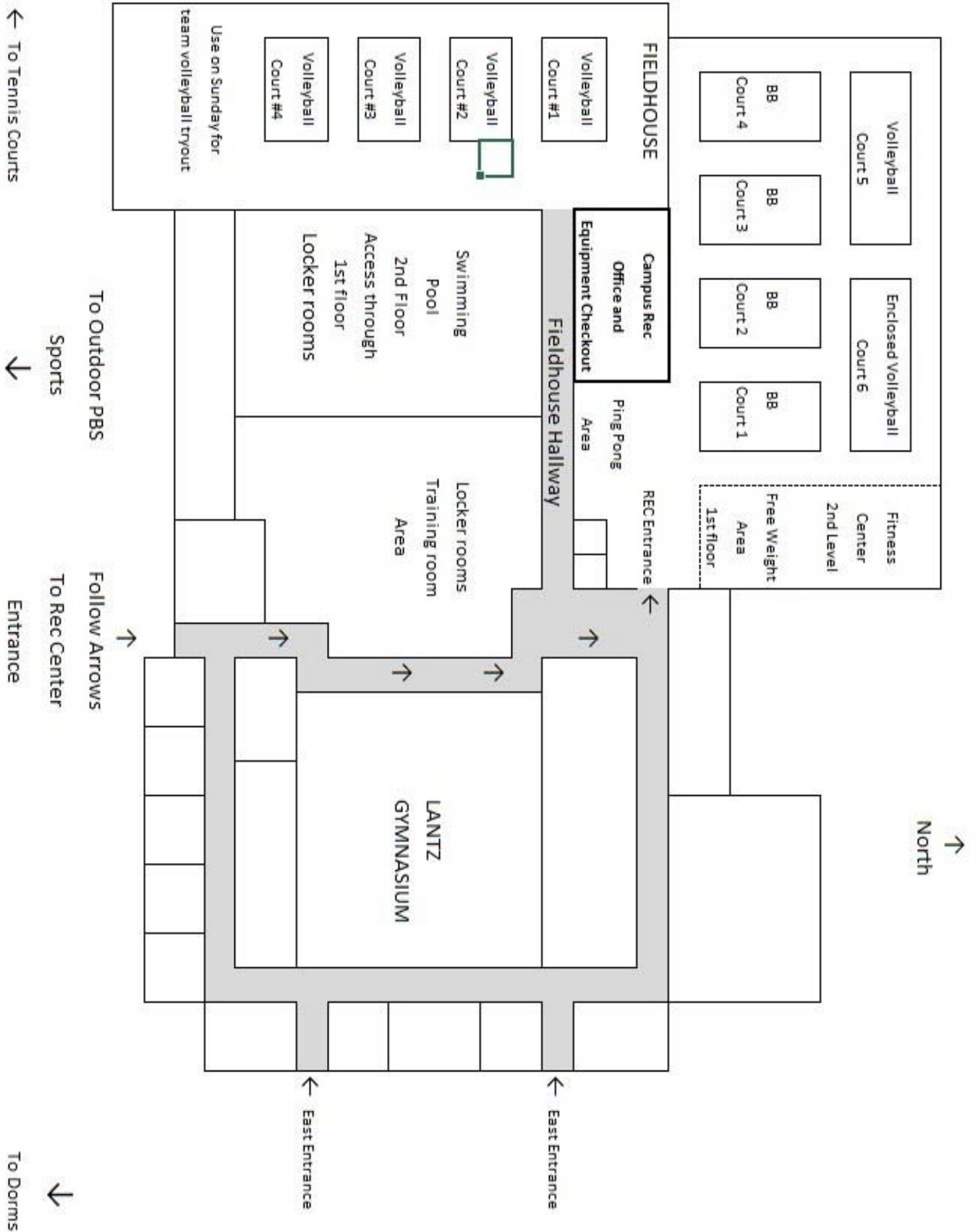

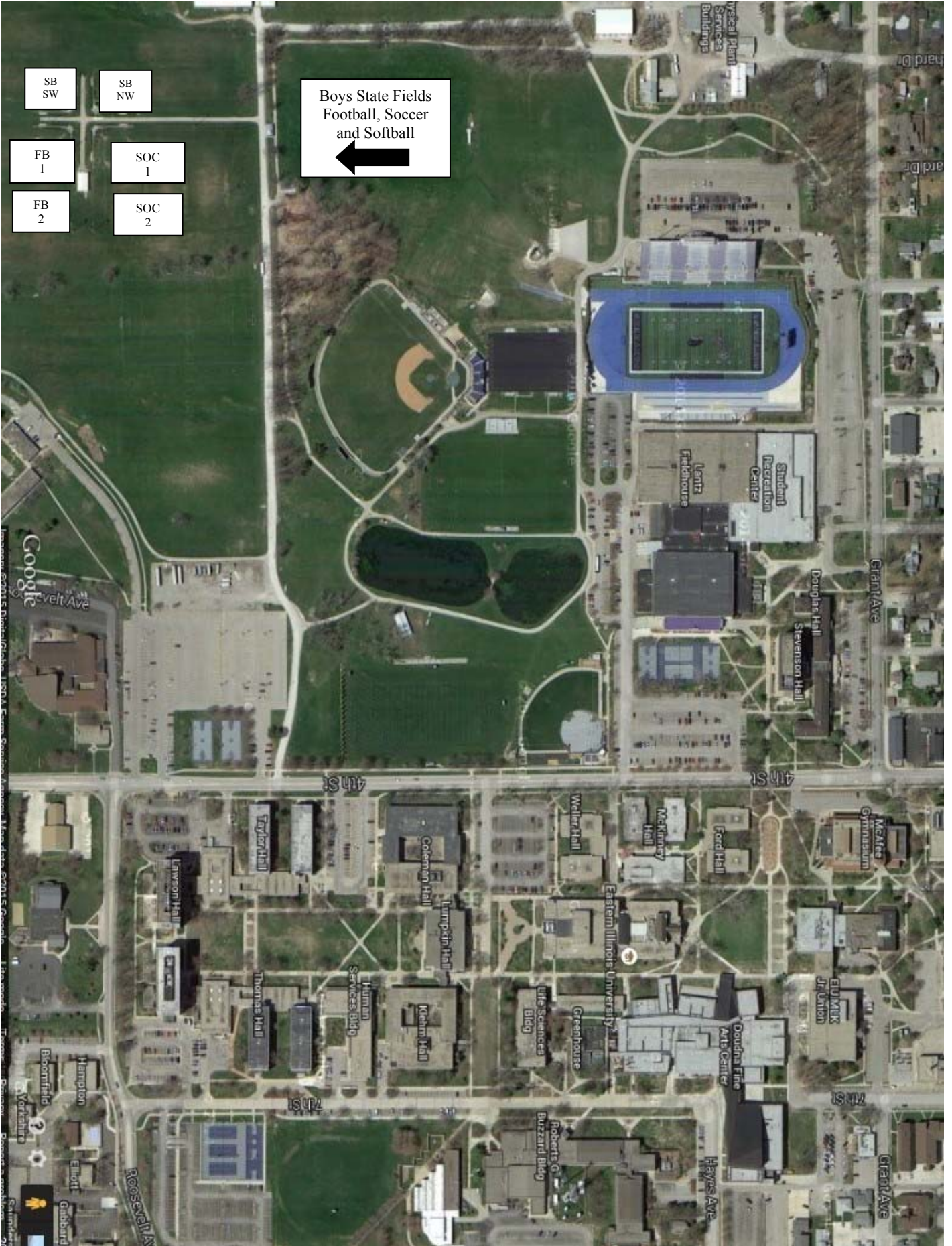

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. A roster must be completed, listing all players per team assigned. Only players listed on the team roster are eligible to participate in that team sport. An ineligible player will cause a forfeiture of the game.
2. Any player playing in more than one sport or with the wrong team/ county will be disqualified from all sports and the game in which he was ineligible to participate will be forfeited.
3. Officials have complete and final authority in the calls, including judgment calls.
4. Abusive language and unnecessary roughness to any official, staff member, coach, player or spectator will not be tolerated. Any player involved in such action will be suspended from all sports. If the occurrence is on the final day, the player will immediately be disqualified and requested to leave the area and report to the Director of Counselors.
5. Any team not present for play after ten (10) minutes of the assigned starting time will forfeit the contest.
6. Coaches must be present with their teams at the start of the game and remain for the entire contest. If it becomes absolutely necessary for the coach to leave, another counselor of that county must assume control.
7. Any team using illegal or ineligible player will forfeit the game, without discrimination.
8. Any dispute of any nature, or any protest by any coach, team or player, not otherwise covered by the assigned official for the contest, will be submitted to the Boys State Director of Athletics for final resolution.

TEAM SPORTS TRYOUT TIMETABLE

IN CASE OF RAIN

Outdoor games will be canceled anytime there is a steady rain beyond a drizzle, or lightning anywhere near enough to be seen. If canceled, the games will be made up the following day by playing abbreviated half games prior to the regularly scheduled game for that day which will also be played as a 1/2 game in each sport as indicated below:

- Softball 3 Innings
- Soccer 2 halves - 10 minutes long
- Flag Football 2 halves – 2 possessions each

The decision to play or not to play due to rain is not made until 12 noon. If the games are still on at noon but it rains after noon, the decision is made on the field at game time. The officials, **not the coaches**, determine if games will be played.

ULTIMATE FRISBEE

During the Thursday afternoon recreation time, boys not playing in one of the sports championships can participate in Ultimate Frisbee in the Field-House. The designated counselor can retrieve the equipment from the SRC Office and the Rope for the Housing Office. Ultimate Frisbee will only be available if there is enough citizen interest.
